Is the United States truly UNDER GOD?

SOME CLAIM the United States is *Under God* because God is acknowledged

- in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag,
- on our money, in our songs,
- as our national motto,
- and in the Declaration of Independence.

But these words, songs, and documents have no authority to legally define our nation. That is the job of our United States Constitution.

DID YOU KNOW all 50 States acknowledge a Supreme Being in their Constitutions?

Their Constitutions define their States in relationship to God. The 50 States, however, do not define the United States as a whole. That is the job of the United States Constitution.

DID YOU KNOW God is not mentioned in the United States Constitution?

At a Crossroads:

AS WE STAND at this amazing crossroads in U.S. history – four hundred years after the Mayflower Compact which did acknowledge God and the Christian walk, rendering America four hundred years of blessings—we face:
